Daily Schedule

The schedule is for Monday to Friday, there is no class at the weekend. The schedule can be adjusted.

Students will take placement test at the first day, then take Qualifying tests every 4 weeks.

Vocabulary test is facilitated daily to check how student learns vocabulary. Students must recall and comprehend 20/30/40 words per day from Monday to Thursday by having through the vocabulary test by recording their pronunciation for the words and on Friday, students will take a weekly Vocabulary test for all the words of the week.

On the student's first day, the school will give them the required daily materials. Students will have the chance to pick up new vocabulary in this activity, which will also help them grasp it better and apply it to their daily lives.

Individual Class

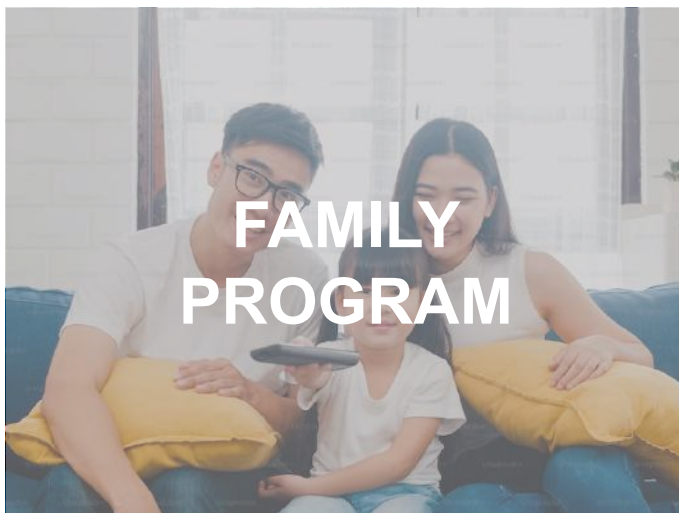

Registration

Cancellation and Refund Policy

1. When the student cancels the study two weeks prior the starting date, tuition fee will be refunded 100% except the enrollment fee 100\$.
